Good Catch Program

Preventing injuries and unplanned events by identifying and controlling industrial safety and human performance risks before harm occurs across all work environments.

What is a Good Catch

Identifying a hazard or risk and taking action to prevent injury, damage, or an unplanned event before it occurs.

High Risk Hazards

Line of fire, stored energy, dropped objects, work at height, rigging, SIMOPS, barriers, and changing conditions.

Critical Behaviors

Stop work when conditions change, question assumptions, strengthen controls, ask for help, and speak up without fear of blame.

Reporting

Capture hazard, action taken, and contributing conditions. For learning only, not blame or discipline.

Leadership Response

Respond positively, avoid blame, reinforce reporting, and share lessons learned in daily communications.

Use of Data

Use Good Catches to find weak signals and improve controls. Not for performance tracking or punishment.

Recognition

Recognize strong hazard identification and prevention behaviors, not report volume.

Supervisor Role

Support stop-work, thank reporting, ask learning questions, reinforce in briefs, and use trends to improve planning. Never discourage reporting.

Key Message

Good Catches show the system is working by stopping risk before harm occurs
